

§10K Raffle RULES AND REGULATIONS

ELIGIBILITY. Entry purchaser, and anyone to whom an entry purchaser legally transfers an entry, must be either a business entity or an individual 21 years or older at time of entry purchase. Individuals buying on behalf of a business/legal entity must be legal representatives of the business and must, themselves, be 21 years or older at the time of entry purchase. Initial entry purchaser must be present in the state of Arizona at the time of entry purchase. It is not necessary to be a resident of the state of Arizona, but one must be physically present in Arizona at the time of entry purchase. Only one (1) individual may be identified as an entry purchaser. All federal, state and local laws and regulations apply. The §10K Raffle (the "Raffle") is conducted in English. Tickets may be purchased after Services on Sundays beginning Feb. 5, 2012 or by contacting Sandi Simpson at 520/490-8400 or bfg_vi@msn.com through March 30, 2012, or until all available tickets are sold. Entry purchasers providing the Raffle with a valid email address will receive confirmation number(s) by return email. A hard copy ticket confirmation number is not required to claim a prize. By entering the Raffle, the entry purchaser acknowledges that he or she is aware of, and agrees to abide by, the Raffle's rules and regulations.

DRAWINGS. Up to two-hundred (200) tickets will be sold for \$100.00 each. Elimination Drawing of Numbers will take place at the §10K Dance on March 31, 2012 at the Rodeo Museum, 4823 S 6th Ave, Tucson, AZ, and beginning at 7:30 p.m. The last number remaining at the end of the Elimination Drawing will be the designated winner of the 50/50 §10K Raffle for a maximum of \$10,000.00 (before taxes). Unsold entry numbers will not be included in the drawing pool and will reduce the amount of total prize proceeds. All entries are non-refundable once an entry has been included in any draw. In the Raffle, there is no possibility of a tie. All draws will be under the supervision of the Drawing Administrator. All time references are Arizona local time.

PRIZE. Maximum prize is \$10,000.00.

NOTIFICATION OF WINNERS. Winner does not need to be present at the §10K Dance. Winner will be notified via email of the requisite procedure to claim the prize, and will have until April 18, 2012, to claim the prize. Using information provided by the Entry Purchaser, if the selected winner is unable to be contacted or located prior to the deadline for claiming the prize, the prize or a cash equivalent will be awarded to the first runner up in the Elimination Drawing if appropriately qualified. In the event a winning ticket has more than one name listed on the ticket, the Drawing Administrator, will physically award the prize to the first name listed on the entry. For tax purposes, the prize can be split among all prize winners. Neither CSLT nor their legal counsel is responsible for resolving disputes which may arise from any conflict between or amongst joint ticket holders or purchasers.

PRIVACY. By entering the Raffle, entry purchasers agree that their information provided in connection with the Raffle entry may be used for communications promoting the Raffle and future raffles sponsored by or conducted for the benefit of CSLT. An entry purchaser may subsequently "opt-out" of the receipt of such communications by following the directions in any e-mail, other communication or by contacting the Drawing Administrator (contact information below). Other than as provided herein, an entry purchaser's information will not be shared with or sold to any other person or entity. Purchase of an entry in the Raffle, constitutes permission for the Raffle and CSLT to use winner's name, address and/or likeness, in perpetuity, for purposes of advertising the Raffle or future raffles without further consent or compensation, unless prohibited by law.

REQUIREMENTS. The winner may be required to execute and return an Affidavit of Eligibility, a Liability Release and a Publicity Release (the "Affidavit/Release"). The Affidavit/Release must be returned by the deadline stated in such documents. If the potential winner fails to return such documents within that time, or if an entrant is found to be ineligible, or if a potential winner does not comply with the Official Rules, then the potential winner will be disqualified and the prize or a cash equivalent will revert the first runner up in the Elimination Drawing.

WAIVER / LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY. Entry purchasers, by participating (and winner, by accepting the cash prize), release CSLT, and their respective parent companies, affiliates, partners, subsidiaries, agents, representatives, sponsors, service agencies and independent contractors, and each of their respective directors, officers, partners, employees and agents, including advertising and promotion agencies, from any and all liability with respect to participation in the promotion, possession, use and distribution of the prize awarded.

DRAWING ADMINISTRATOR. The Drawing Administrator for the §10K Raffle sponsored by The Center for Spiritual Living Tucson (CSLT) located at 3895 North Alvernon Way, Tucson, AZ 85718, 520/319-1042 shall serve in this capacity.

TAXES AND IRS RULES. Winner shall be responsible for any and all federal, state and local income or excise taxes, fees, assessments and like charges associated with the cash prize. The cash prize will be paid net of applicable income tax withholding.

SPECIAL NOTE: At the time of this printing, federal law requires that corresponding tax withholding on prize values of \$5,000 or greater must be collected from winners upon award and distribution. Federal and state withholding laws are subject to change without notice. The withholding laws in effect at the time prizes are claimed will be followed. The IRS has taken the position that amounts paid for chances to participate in raffles, lotteries or similar programs are not gifts and, therefore, the price of the entry does not qualify as a deductible charitable contribution.
