CSL's Report 15 min

<u>Administration</u>: Nothing unusual to report. Jeanne continues to handle all known issues very well. (Janis)

Bookstore: Sherrie states it is slow at the bookstore right now. She is visioning for a copartner and would like another volunteer or two. She also reports that she will be returning some of the books that were obtained for book fair. (Melinda for Sherrie)

<u>Compassionate Heart:</u> Services provided by Compassionate Heart during April 2011: Phone calls: 12, Home visits: 4. We are now fortunate to have 27 members. Next meeting: May 26 at 6:30 pm. (Britt)

<u>Community In/Outreach</u>: "Kundun" was attended by 9 people. The movie for May will be "Genghis Blues". June's movie will be superseded by David Prouty's house concert. (Janis)

Ecclesiastical CORE: Met in April and discussed MOP Income/Expenses over the last couple of years. Kathy Belk will prepare and accounting to present to the Board.

Next Spiritual Tune-ups tentatively scheduled for June potluck Sunday depending on Practitioner availability. (Eugenia Linam, RScP)

Next meeting Thursday, May 26, 6:30pm

Education: Certificated classes include: Prac I completes on Monday, May 30 (3 students, with Rev D), and Power of Your Word completed Tuesday, May 3 (6 students, with Rev D).

Discussion: Rev. Donald indicated that there will be two workshops scheduled. Trance of Abundance is scheduled for Wednesday, May 25. Trance of Wholeness is scheduled for

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Wednesday, June 22. These workshops are in response to an overwhelming number of Ministry of Prayer requests relative to money and health issues. Also a bulletin insert has been be prepared letting congregation know what classes are available and a description of each.

There will also be a preview of the fall Learning Circle material, Trance of Scarcity, offered to the Center's Leadership and potential facilitators beginning on June 28.

Action: Inform Team Leads and known potential facilitators of this learning opportunity and also open it up to potential facilitators from the congregation. (Janis for Team Leaders, Rev D for practitioners.)

Events: A preliminary event proposal, for the house music series in general, not for David Prouty's concert in specific was forwarded to the Board. David has determined the preferred venue (DeeAnn and Zack's office) works, will seat 50+ people and the house concert is scheduled for June 24 at 7 pm.

<u>Discussion</u>: Keith debriefed the Board on the Michele O'Donnell Workshop. The workshop did not meet expectations financially or in attendance. It was felt that the ad in Natural Awakenings did not provide a good return. The Board acknowledged that Natural Awakenings in the past has had a very good return, however, we recognize again that the MarComm needs to discuss having more fit-for-purpose advertising (which they are already scheduled to discuss). Additionally Janis noted that a electronic contact list has been created jointly by Events and MarComm for sharing of events between area churches. It will continue to be refined.

Funding Team: The Funding Team met on April 18th. We will be providing an educational opportunity on the Tax Benefits of Estate Planning after the service on May 15th. There will be inserts for the bulletin on May 1st and 8th as well as a sign up sheet for those who wish to attend so we have enough handouts.

Janie Worrall has agreed to set up the host homes for our fall learning circle program. Sylvia will contact Dakota to see if she will work with Janie, since she has participated before. We want Host Homes set up mid to late July, attendees set up the end of August and the groups will be ready to go at the end of Sept.

Don P. will talk with Patti about the fund raising dance.

Our next meeting will be on Monday, May 16th at 11am.

Discussion: Paul T spoke about the helpfulness of the Tucson Public Library in finding potential granting agencies. Rev Donald wondered if we had anyone within the Center with skills at grant-writing.

Hospitality: Hospitality continues to have new volunteers and has come up with a way to make coffee that doesn't require lifting the heavy full coffee pots. (Lovetta)

<u>Host</u>: Keith recognized that the hosts need to remind the congregation not to park on the west side of the Junior League, per the request of the Junior League signage, and he asked the host team to do so.

<u>Marcomm:</u> 1) Paul has indicated interest in polling the committee to get impressions about the "value" of our advertising dollars. He would like to do that at an upcoming face-to-face meeting.

2) We MAY be having a face-to-face MarComm Core meeting on 5/21. Paul's weekly

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evening schedule and my need to be home for Sophia until school is out has us looking to a Saturday meeting. I still need to check with the rest of the committee to see if they can be available on 5/21 and at what time. If 5/21 doesn't work we will have to wait for a face to face until after June 10^{th.}

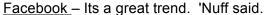
- 3) Rick Fisher will be leaving for the summer so we will need to include him by phone if possible.
- 4) Several "usual" marketing expenses are due and available to renew such as our Go Daddy URL/domain name and Yellow Pages.
- 5) Also, we have been contacted by several local area groups and invited to advertise with them. (Examples include KGUN, KOLD, MIX97......) I will reserving any action on this until the "advertising" review Paul wants to conduct is complete.
- 6) The Youth Ministry has asked for the opportunity to build a platform for their program to have more exposure. This will be taken under consideration. Kevin Anderson has been asked to attend an upcoming Sunday session with the Youth and Teen ministry to learn more about what could be and to offer his expertise.
- 7) Graeme Hunt continues to support us with website tweaks as necessary. He is also preparing graphic design that is complementary to our website for the Blog, You Tube, and Facebook Splash pages.
- 8) Kevin Anderson, Lynden Kidd and Janis Farmer met last week to talk about next steps with the Faces campaign; a feature on the educational service of CSLT especially taking advantage of the upcoming certification/graduation ceremony; and the evolution of our various communication channels. The newsletter continues to be a key element in our strategy with increasing emphasis on "teaser" pieces with links back to articles posted on the blog and to other content; video posted on YouTube and event descriptions posted on the website and Facebook. Kevin will coordinate with Graeme about this.
- 9) We continue to need "content" in the can before we launch the Blog August 1st. It will launch with articles to post already written; and a video "story" from the Faces Campaign.
- 10) The Faces campaign starting in August of 2011 will target release of a "Faces" personal story one per month skipping months we have release of a detailed "Core" story or CSLT "Event" story. The goal being that we routinely get content for both the blog and for the "Core" video from core teams.
- 11) There is recognition that we need to build a "writing" team composed of people who are good at writing short articles and who can interface with core and board team leads to develop articles of interest to share in our media.
- 12) There was also discussion about creating a photo archive for CSLT using a service called Zen Folio. We would then invite the membership to submit photos that we can use now and in the future for our media campaigns. Kevin will set up the archive and a call will go out asking for photos to include. Also since we are developing the educational story any photos of CSLT classes are requested.
- 13) We also discussed the need for a Master Calendar to track key dates. LK will get an example to the board of the timeline needed and why a Master Calendar would be helpful.
- 14) We are also working with Karen King, Bruce Matlock, Jeff Small and Zack Saber on updating the business directory. We believe that we can develop an online sign up for members who wish to participate. There was discussion about a community directory; but there was concern around compulsory participation.
- 15) There is also thought that this committee needs to develop a "marketing plan" with details around usual key CSLT events that could be available. We don't want to get bogged down in plan writing however and we do want to keep everyone moving forward.

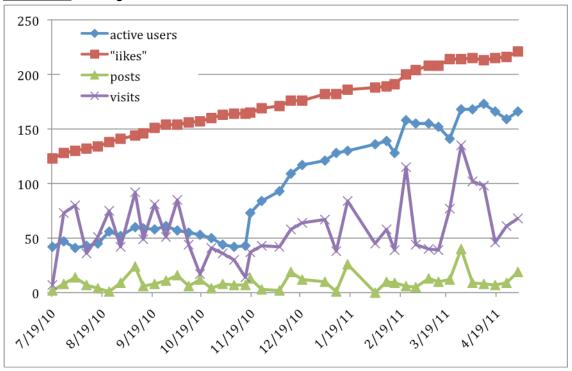
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Action: The Board approved the expenditure for ZenFolio at an annual rate of between \$25-50.

The Board recognizes a need for a writer's group to be formed, with the focus on the unveiling of the Blog on August 1 and that blog posts will need to be written.

The Board had previously approved the Business Directory.





<u>Newsletter</u> – 571 subscribers and counting, up 1 from last month. We have had several more people subscribe, but have also had more un-subscribe.

<u>Website</u> – Nothing special to report. Graeme continues to be responsive to requests and do a good job.

<u>Membership</u>: Two additional membership orientations have been scheduled for Sept 11&18 and Dec 4&11. (Kathryn)

Move Core/Facilities:

The Move Core has been very active the past two months looking at potential properties and holding various meetings to evaluate our findings.

We looked at an existing church located on Sunrise near Westward Look Resort. This facility was complete and would fit most of CSLT's needs, with the exception of a sufficient sized fellowship hall. Also, the property was "plain vanilla" and didn't have the esthetic appeal that has run through our visioning. The Move Core decided not to go further with this property at this time.

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The next property we looked at was Casa de las Rosas on River Road, near Sabino Canyon Rd. All of the Move Core was in full agreement that the property was unique, beautiful, and very spiritual. We all also agreed that we could make it work for CSLT with considerable effort. But in spite of this there was not a consensus to move forward with this project. After an in-depth, heart-felt discussion by everyone, the majority of the team, for a variety of reasons, voted not to pursue the property.

After the disappointment of this decision abated (somewhat) Barbara Palmer suggested we re-visit the Corona Ranch at 7595 E. Snyder. The Core had seen this property a couple of years ago. On May 5 we toured the facility and in most cases were pleasantly surprised at its natural beauty and potential. So on May 10, the Move Core met again to evaluate the property. Again, we were in agreement that this property could work for CSLT but there were several contingencies that had to be resolved before it would work. Some, but not all, of the contingencies that we discussed:

The well water supply (was it sufficient?). Is the parking area "ok" to build on? What is the structural integrity of the lodge?

In addition to the questions that were raised the Core discussed the positives of the property which included the feel and beauty of the area, the potential to co-create the ideas that are CSLT's vision, and we can immediately have our spiritual center under one roof.

The Core voted to recommend to the Board that we consider acquiring the property, assuming that all of the contingencies can be corrected and that favorable terms can be negotiated with the seller. Detailed plans will be developed jointly with the Core and Board if the board also agrees to move forward. (Barbara and Don)

Action: The Board to discuss this topic tonight.

Music/Sound: Sound Team soliciting additional volunteers.

Between no-shows, older/sicker folks no longer willing or able and those leaving for summer we're in a real drought and no longer have enough people to be on a 2 month rotation schedule. Action: Ask Rev D to acknowledge Ushers and call for more volunteers during the gratitude moment one Sunday.

Volunteer Coordination: Presently handled by Jeanne. Thanks Jeanne.

Action: Inform Team Leaders of people who have volunteered to work in their respective areas. (Janis with Jeanne)

Youth & Family: (Laura Nier)

1. Tools Report. We unveiled our recent donated tool, the Wii and related accessories. Due

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to time constraints the teens were the only group able to review the Wii tool, make recommendations re accessories and play a game (bowling was chosen). It was interesting to watch their eyes light up both at the prospect of playing and also understanding what I was asking of them which was to identify and name GOD qualities they were using while playing with each other on this tool. Prior to using the Wii Tool, we worked the weeks lesson on intuition and the connection between it, GOD qualities and making choices. This was a great transition to the Tool. We didn't hear it was time to come over otherwise several of them were going to share their answers to the question in paragraph 1 above.

Eddie, our emissary, did share thoughts with Donald and Janis after the ceremony. There isn't any question in my mind this Tool will prove to be invaluable. Interest and learning enthusiasm are very high. Those are parameters we want to see. Having the youth actively involved in the learning process and attending forms the foundation for continued success.

2. Donor Recognition. I think recognizing Mary Margaret's donation to the Youth Ministry is a priority. Do we have a usual way to recognize donors?
