Shelly Dunn continues to do the bulk of the online Sunday morning meditations.

We continued online Sunday services (through zoom). A diversity of regulars and new people keep appearing, and we get better at doing it, and individuals get more comfortable in the stay-home-isolation-mode of doing Sunday services.

Rev Janis continues the morning daily practice (on zoom). In October there were 271 individual points of contact and 26 group affirmative prayers; in September there were 290 individual points of contact and 26 group affirmative prayers as part of this activity. This was the first month we have shown a reduction in attendance and participation since our zoom room daily morning practice began in mid-March. The end of October marks 192 consecutive days (excluding Sundays, when we were meeting as a congregation.)
