

What Does The Center for Spiritual Living Tucson Look Like in the Year 2012?



These notes are from four different sources. The strategic planning results from November 2008, the congregational visioning of October 16, 2009, the November 13, 2009 Strategic Planning session, and December 13, 2009 planning session held in the Kiva after Sunday services.

At the last planning session, the attendees identified which of these strategic elements are most critical to implement first. These most critical elements were then placed on a timeline and owners were assigned to each. This timeline with the critical elements will be coming soon, it's still in process.
